## **Research Statement and Interests**

My work revolves at the nexus of health and wellbeing in leisure and tourism contexts, adopting a gender-sensitive and a life course-grounded approach. I focus on risky behaviors (e.g., sexual risk taking and violence perpetration and victimization) and general vulnerable populations (e.g., adolescents and older adults) as well as specific at-risk populations (youth involved in gangs).

My research contributes to a deeper understanding of these issues and offers directions for health education programs and prevention/intervention methods. Thus, my research interests are:

- Youth in gangs and the cycles of violence and victimization
